1. Website

A paragraph is a group of sentences developing a single idea or topic. A paragraph should be long enough to develop the main idea clearly. This idea is usually summed up in the first sentence (the 'Topic Sentence'). A paragraph should then elaborate, explain, or define this topic further. It should also use evidence, examples, and illustrations to support the main point of the paragraph. Finally, a paragraph should be between 100-200 words in length.
